

Delhi, 29 July 07 (Sun)

My dear Satya Pal Bhai,

Your letter of 23 July was received yesterday, Saturday, 28 July. We were glad to receive some news from you directly and hope you and Vinla are both keeping well. Yes, you did mention 15,00 copies of the Punjabi edition and I think it must be correct since you had written that letter soon after your contact with the Dosh Bhagat Yadgar committee.

Please don't take my comments on translation to heart. I am sure the Punjabi translators and editors will do a good job. You had mentioned that Prof. Parwana would do the translation.

Sumit's wife Gargi Chakravarty rang up today to say that her book on P.C. Joshi will be released tomorrow evening. She asked for your address to send you a copy

and I gave the Ekta Bhawan address. She also said she and Sumit had both gone to Calcutta for about 10 days and she had read on the way Vinla's "fragments." She said she liked the book as well as the foreword and Afterword very much. She said also that she had given a copy to Gautam Chattopadhyay's son and so at least one copy has reached Calcutta!

Akshay arrived alone on 27th at 4 p.m. His flight from Chennai was late by many hours. He has left the two children with Abha in Chennai. He will return to Chennai on 6th Aug. Then he, the children and Virginia will come here for 3-4 days on 17th Aug. They all leave on 22 Aug. morning back to Paris.

Virginia is coming late as her passport renewal was delayed. Now that Akshay has agreed to take us tomorrow to the release function of Gargi's book on PCJ, we hope to attend the function. Bipan Chandra's term as National Book Trust Chairman is ~~the~~ ending soon, hence they were in a hurry to publish the PCJ biography.

Gargi says she is very dissatisfied with her book on PCS as it had to be written along with her college work and she did not get enough time to write.

Let us see the book and then only we can form an opinion. A copy

of Vinod's book has also gone to Bipan Chandra.

Now about Chusno briefly. She has sent the IT form after signing it to her C.A. Now she is busy submitting her papers for the Green Card application. The American embassy has sent her a large big questionnaire, with a large no. of documents they need. All these

have to be procured, attested and then sent to them by the middle of August. Chusno has never done this work before and gets very agitated. I spent all 26th July afternoon in the High Court with her, trying to sign an Affidavit about her date of birth. Then we found it was not needed at all. Naveen was with us all the time and

had given me a lift on his way from Noida. Mona Chauha was also with us.

Chunna was feeling bad about asking you and Vinla repeatedly to postpone ~~her~~ your visit to Delhi, but she feels that she cannot go through the strain until the Green Card affair is settled. She now feels that it may be easier for ~~you~~ her to come herself to A'sar for a day and meet you and Vinla. She says if ~~she~~ ^{she} can meet you at Chandigarh, it may be even better as it is nearer and you also go there some times. (Shekhar has once again sent her a message that he is coming, but again he has not indicated a clear date.)

On the way back from Nizamuddin Naveen suggested that we may pick up Kamal on the way and then go to see Roopan who had arrived a couple of days earlier. He called up Kamal on his mobile and told her to get ready. So we stopped at Mayapuri

Vihar for a few minutes, collected Kamal and then went to Noida to meet Roopan. (The rest of the family - Anoop, Divya and Mayank left for a short holiday abroad soon after they arrived in Delhi.) We found Roopan quite changed after her stroke some months ago. When she was asked where they were after they arrived in Delhi by plane, she replied, "Lahore". When we saw her, she welcomed us happily and when asked who I was, said, "Ravi". But she could not recognise Kamal and said she could not recall her name. Then we were informed that she calls every male "Ravi" and every woman "Vimla". Naveen said they will take her to a hospital for treatment and they hope she will gradually be all right.

Akshay during his stay here is trying to find a good diabetologist for Kamal and a good urologist and a gastroenterologist for me in a hospital not too far from here, so that we can have local consultants too and not depend entirely on the Chennai doctor. There is some hope of finding

Such doctors through some of Akshay's friends in this area.

Well, I have tried to give you all the news in this long letter. Perhaps you are right in thinking of changing residence every one or two years, as you write. As for us, we think it difficult to plan so far ahead as long as Chunno and Nanna remain in Delhi. We have just to wait, which is not a very good situation.

Please share this letter with Vinla. Anoop and family will be back in Delhi by 8 August I think. Then they will rent a house flat in Noida and return to Hyderabad to wind up their establishment. There as Anoop has retired It is good that Naveen and heeta are here to look after Roopan.

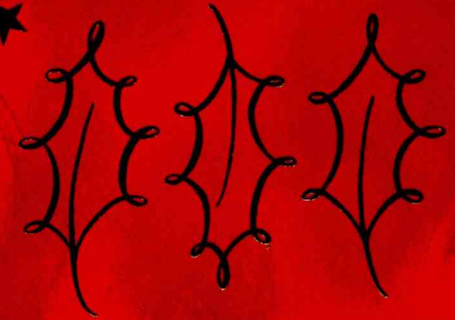

This was the height of ~~the~~ sectarianism combined with crass refusal to share power with others ~~1955~~ After 1955 by election defeat, the party has been steadily shrinking with other factors also contributing to this process.

After spending so long years of selfless service is it unfair to hope that the party should grow over coming the hurdles? Is it unfair to expect natural justice from it? Neither the state committee, nor the state and central Control Commissions nor for that matter, even the general Secy, simply ignore my appeal against removal, without even acknowledge the receipt of appeal, leave alone doing justice.

Now I quite understand the miserable plight of poor Dr. Upadhi in the open court of Shuryodhans when she was ~~de~~ stripped of her salary! Nobody, even the great Bhishma did not protest! Only Vikarna raised his voice only to be asked to keep quiet. Today's party committees are in such a miserable condition of helpless spectators. A party committee which can not fight injustice, can it fight outside?





Now for your objections:

From 1951 to 1964 (Split of the party) two groups were working under the same banner expressing their opinions frankly, I am not mentioning anything new.

In spite of going to Moscow and all that, the armed struggle continued in Telangana and before the elections C.R. and our group withdrew the arm struggle and others called us revisionists. They withdrew the armed struggle after Madhurai conference.

This means that tactics should flow not from the target but based on the Zeta of the General Secretary. Further in the executive meeting, Bardhan said that the whole bourgeoisie has gone over to the imperialism. I held that as long as the imperialism is there, a section may go over but the rest will come with the democratic forces. He concluded that, that period was over (second party Congress position). In the executive nobody opened their mouth.



My own view is that in all probability it contains writings of Gurm Gobind Singh and ~~of these~~ ^{of these} ~~of~~ ^{his} poets who regularly attended his "darbars" at Anandpur Sahib. The circumstances of Gurm's departure from Anandpur Sahib and his subsequent life were so full of hardships that he could not even maintain the most minimum of any records etc. Legend has it that all his books and other literature were washed and destroyed in the 'Sarsa Nadi' that he had to cross being because Mughal army was in hot pursuit. But many of his followers kept copies of his 'Bani' including presumably the 'Dasam Granth' and so it survived.

Most sicks, believe that Dasam

Granth as it is available today contains the Bani of the ^{and of him alone} Guru, but I doubt that the Guru would be wasting his time in writing or re-writing old stories of love and intrigue which also form a part of the available texts, ~~which also has~~ ^{and contains} some really wonderful poetry in praise of God. What is important from my point of view is that when Guru Gobind Singh compiled the Granth Sahib at Daudan Sahib and ^{later} gave it the status of the 'Guru' of Sikhs for all times to come he did not include any text from the 'Dasam Granth' or even of any other 'Bani' by him, except one or two small poems.

According to Khushwant Singh many scholars including famous authors like Macauliff and Cunningham do not believe ~~all~~ that all the writings in the 'Dasam Granth' are those by the 10th Guru. He is in agreement with this view.

Quite often the issue gets raked up due to ambiguity of authorship. The questions are genuine but the Sikh clergy would seize upon any opportunity to get publicity and perpetrate their authority. I agree with Gurbtej Singh I.A.S. that research should be allowed in this field. But Gurbtej is not interested in the subject as a genuine scholar. He is the one who spearheaded the campaign to deny the status of a martyr to Bhagat Singh and to say that he started believing in God before execution. I would (as far as writing is concerned) like to avoid

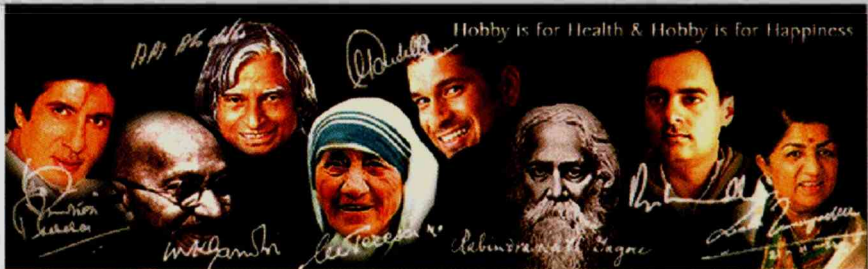

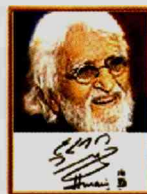

In theme of Music Maestros this is presented in a different way. Here categories of Sitar Maestros, Tabla Maestros etc. are shown together.
- This Website is to project the autographs of Indian celebrities. However due to their Indian connections, some other nationals like Edmund Hillary, Lord Mountbatten are included in the website.
- Some categories contain a year-based or tenure-based theme. Here an effort is made to maintain the chronology. And in doing so, even if the autograph or photograph of a particular celebrity is not available the blank space is left. This is so done to help the collector and show him the completeness of the theme.
- Under the toolbar icon of 'Hobby of Autographs' the collectors and readers get detailed information regarding this hobby in a Question-Answer form.
- Under the toolbar icon of 'Thematic Lists' one can find thematic lists of different categories and under toolbar icon of 'Alphabetical List' one can find all the autographs alphabetically arranged. One can go to any autograph by clicking the name from any list.
- Moreover, under the toolbar icon of 'Useful Links', collector will be able to find URL IDs of many useful links related to autographs or celebrities created by individuals or institutions or organizations.
- Here on this website an effort is made to project different themes under which a collection can be made. A sincere effort is made to put as many autographs as possible in a particular theme. Thus the website will provide an opportunity to the collector to compare his autograph with the original autograph of the celebrity.

Please refer to your letter dated 24th April, 2007 enclosing a letter from Shri Satyapal Dang, Ex-MLA regarding obscenity in advertisements.

2. As far as the Print Media is concerned, this Ministry does not exercise any legal control over the advertisements appearing in the Print Media.

3. As regards action taken by my Ministry against private TV Channels for telecast of obscene advertisements/programmes since January, 2007:

- (i) Sixteen Show Cause Notices have been issued to the Private TV Channels for violation of Programme Code and Advertising Code prescribed under Cable Television Networks (Regulation) Act, 1995 and rules framed thereunder.
- (ii) Nine Warnings/Advisories have been issued to the TV Channels to strictly adhere, in future, to the Programme and Advertising Codes prescribed under the said Act, failing which strict action, including taking the channel off the air, will be taken against them.
- (iii) Transmission/re-transmission of two Private TV Channels namely AXN and FTV.Com India has been prohibited for a specific period on all the platforms in the Indian Territory.

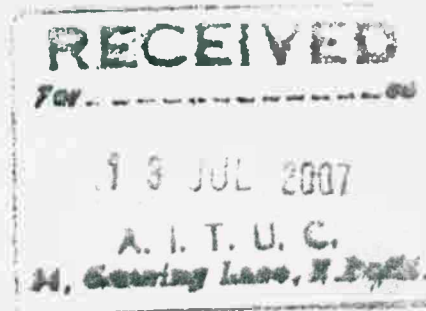





1. System of Sanitation (Sweeping) through Mohalla Committees has proved a total failure. In addition it has resulted in lot of corruption. This needs to be replaced by the original system of ~~basins~~ urban local bodies having regular Safai Karamcharis of their own with every urban local body having adequate number of such employes ~~with~~ plus adequate number of leaving reservists

This alone will ensure proper sweeping (Safai) in towns. Matter may please be treated as urgent.

2. I also wish to draw your urgent and personal attention to the very sad plight of rag pickers. This work is so filthy that it reduces the life of a rag picker almost to half. Following two measures need to be taken urgently:

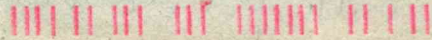
