Sir,

I am a Retd. Govt. employe getting a pension of Rs. 11000/- only p.m. My wife named Urmil, is a Punjabi teacher working in Govt. Middle School, Babu Labh Singh Nagar Jalandhar and its complex school is Govt. High School Basti Bawa Khel Jalandhar. Urmil is a cancer patient for last 14 years.

Cancer, starting from the breast in April 1993 had spread over all the bones including the skull till 2005 and now it has crept in liver at six places. Spending heavily on medicines and medical services she had been submitting the medical bills quite in time. Since Aug. 2004 till July 07 she submitted bills to the tunes of Rs. 187941.65. (Detail attached)

It is regretfully stated that only Rs. 9183/- at serial number 5 have been re-imbursed till now inspite of the fact that many of the bills have been cleared by the Director of health & family welfare Punjab. A photo copy of the Director health & family welfare Punjab's letter is enclosed herewith. Urmil i.e. the patient gets Rs. 19000/- p.m. after all the deductions of funds, whereas she has to spend almost Rs. 20000/- p.m. on treatment and diet.

From above facts and figures you can guess easily that in how miserable condition we are living.

In the long run I pray you, please expedite the matter to help me to keep her body and soul together.

# Did Bhagat Singh visit Bara Makana?

Had Bhagat Singh and Sukdev visited "Bara Makana" (cluster of dozen houses) in the Shaheed Islamabad locality here and taken shelter in the house of freedom fighter Sohan Singh Josh in 1928 after shooting ASP of Lahore J.P. Saunders?

The issue has become murkier with claims and counterclaims being made by leaders of various political parties and residents of "Bara Makana". While deputy commissioner Kahan Singh Pannu has ordered an inquiry into the matter, Laxmi Kanta Chawla, health minister,

and veteran CPI leader Satyapal Dang have alleged that Dev Dard, a Punjabi poet, was "misguiding" the public by claiming that Bhagat Singh and Sukhdev took shelter in his rented house.

After visiting the site of "Bara Makana", Dang and his wife alleged that Dev Dard had succeeded in illuminating his house at the expense of the local administration on the eve of the birth centenary of Shaheed Bhagat Singh. Dang alleged that the Punjabi poet had "cooked up" the story for "selfish interests".

On the other hand, CPI district secretary Amarjit Singh Asal, CPM leader Vijay Mishra, Dev Dard, and noted story writer Tal-

winder in a press conference have claimed that the course of events given in the autobiography of Sohan Singh Josh were correct and that the great freedom fighters had visited the site after the assassination of the British officer in Lahore.

They also produced historical documents to substantiate their claims. However, Asal said it was not yet clear which house Josh took on rent where Bhagat Singh and Sukhdev took shelter.

Interestingly, the locality's most famous guests also included Netaji Subhas Chander Bose who visited the place while escaping to Kabul, popularly known as the

'Great Escape'.

Most of the residents of Amritsar seem to be oblivious of one of the best kept secrets that Bhagat Singh used to edit 'Kirti', a newspaper of revolutionaries along with Sohan Singh Josh for secret circulation from Bara Makana in the local Islamabad area.

Netaji had a brief stopover at Amritsar en route to Afghanistan that generated patriotic fervour among the local residents. A resident of Bara Makana, which was the hub of revolutionaries, established the visit of Netaji to Amritsar who escaped to Kabul in disguise with the help of the revolutionaries of Punjab.

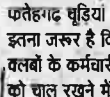

Not only will it cost them dearly in the General Election, it will boost reactionary elements in our country. On the other hand, the

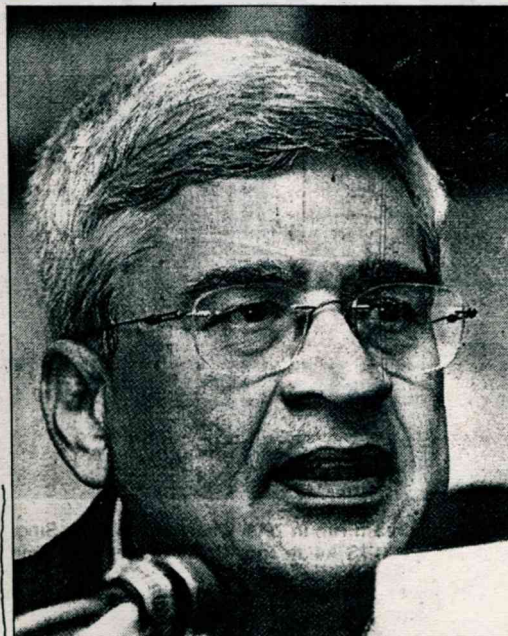

Dear Comrade Anshiji,

yesterday I received your letter dated 18/08/07.

Sequence of events in question, to the best of my knowledge and belief is as under:

A news appeared in the media which criticised the Party of yourself in relation to the matter in question. There was no rejoinder either from the Party or yourself, or anyone else. It was then that I happened to meet a member of the State Sectt of the Party. I formed the ~~prima~~ prima-face opinion that criticism in the press was not unwarranted. It was then that I considered it my duty to write to look into the matter. I think (& that is my view even now) that I did the right thing because it is the State Sectt. or state leadership was the appropriate authority to take a view and then decide.

I know that there are leaders who think that criticism/allegations made in the media, need not be taken notice of. In my opinion it is not always a correct view. In the case in question I was of the view that you should have at least refuted the allegation. Or you could have said that let the matter be enquired into by the Party or the Govt. You didn't react at all. It was on this background that I wrote to the Central Sectt.

I am fully aware of your records as MLA but that does not rule out any omission or mistake. Not when allegation is made, and it goes unrefuted, it will allow many readers to presume that the same is correct.

Someone in ASR also said that I should have asked you to clarify. I told him that when an allegation is made in the press, prompt refutation should come from the comrade concerned. If it does not come, misunderstanding is likely.

It was in this background that I thought it necessary & correct to bring the matter to the notice of the G. Sectt you being a N.C. member. With Best wishes & regards from both of us to

There is a town in district Gujranwala with the RAMNAGER as its official name. Muslims who were in majority would call it Rasul Nagar. It had an elected municipal Committee. Barkat Ali (perhaps Sayyad - I am not sure - and so I would say Janale Barkat Ali would be elected ~~Barak~~ President and Shri Gyan Chand would be Vice President.

Ramnagar was not on any Raw Railway line. To catch any train one would have to go to the Akalgarh Railway Station. Akalgarh was about 6 miles (10 kilometers) away. Akalgarh was more or less right in the centre (middle) of Hafizabad & Wazirabad. People would go by tongas from Ramnagar to Akalgarh.

I was born in Ramnagar and received my education there in the Govt middle school. For higher education one had to go Akalgarh & for post Matric education to some bigger town. There used to be complete communal peace and harmony.

THERE WAS IN RAMNAGER, HAVELI OF MAHARAJA RANJIT SINGH - a massive building built with the small sized bricks - in a dilapidated condition - perhaps what stood there could only be called Khondrat. We would be told that the Maharaja would come to Ramnagar and live in this haveli off & on.

# ASI discovers antique fountains

The Archeological Survey of India (ASI) has stumbled upon antique fountains and water channels, dating back to the period of Maharaja Ranjit Singh, from the Civil Defence Services Building as part of the conservation and restoration project taken up in the historic Ram Bagh.

In an interview with The Tribune, project architect Gurmeet Rai, who was in the city to attend a meeting with ASI officials, said it had been decided to commission the restoration work to a private contractor having experience in the field of conservation of historic buildings.

"Within a period of six months, most buildings inside Ram Bagh, including the summer palace of Maharaja Ranjit Singh, would be restored. One-quarter of the garden would also be laid out," she said.

On the hue and cry raised by certain environmentalists on the demolition of the baradaris inside Ram Bagh, she said the ASI did the right thing considering the pathetic condition of the structures. "The reinforcements had rotten over the years and the condition of the stone structures was also far from satisfactory," she said.

It was in July 1999 that the

director, cultural affairs, and the museum department, in a communication with the deputy commissioner, Amritsar, had urged the handing over the charge of buildings situated in Ram Bagh to them, after it was declared a protected monument.

The letter reads: "You are well aware that the whole of Ram Bagh has been declared protected as per the Government of Punjab notification dated October 8, 1997. This garden is to be developed as per the rules of the department."

Any kind of activity was also prohibited inside Ram Bagh, including marriage parties and political rallies. It was also decided that the three clubs functioning inside the garden would be shifted out, in view the heritage value of the site. A copy of the letter was sent to the municipal corporation for ensuring eviction of the clubs from the historic building.

The government of Punjab, department of tourism and cultural affairs, vide notification dated April 10, 1997, had ordered protection and maintenance of ancient and historic places under sub-section 4 (1) of the Punjab Ancient and Historic Buildings and Sites Act, 1964.

Being old age (86+), I have some problems with my eye, because of which I cannot read U. much. Generally speaking I only read headlines of two or three newspapers that gives me some idea about what is happening in our state & in our country. [I will try to read your article about Bhagat Singh - but I am not sure whether I would be able to. ~~You~~ Perhaps you will recall that Punjabi, our mother tongue, was not the medium of instruction even at the primary stage during our days. Urdu was the medium in all Govt schools. As far as Punjabi is concerned, I never learnt Punjabi at any stage of my education. Up to middle stage, ~~Punjabi~~ Urdu was the medium and of that English. At a much later one stage, I learnt Hindi privately from our Pandit. And in my graduation stage of education, I had Hindi as an optional subject. I did pass but I cannot boast about much knowledge of Hindi. I hardly read any Hindi book after my graduation and never wrote in it. As far as Punjabi in Gurmukhi script is concerned, I never wrote or even some words in it. Of course, I learnt to read Punjabi

in Gurmukhi script to be able to read NZ. By now because of old age, I read headlines of NZ besides those of English Tribune and Urdu Hind Samachokar. Occasionally I have a look at one Hindi Daily too but that only irregularly. You can therefore imagine how much handicapped I have been as far as Pujabi is concerned, though I am a born Pujabi and can't do speak Pujabi fluently. However, all that I have said above should give you some idea how much handicapped I have been, rather unfortunate also. But that is life. Or should I say, what British rule in India concretely meant for me and maybe for my be many others of my generation—how it hit us in the field of education.

Coming back to the Great Martyr, on 2<sup>nd</sup> night there was a massive function in ASR Khalsa college. Badal presided. Audience of huge. Programme on the whole, was excellent. (We could not stay till the end because <sup>of</sup> our (both of us) physical limitation). During the programme, we there was also a reference to what Bhagat Singh had ~~once~~ said about Communist Party. I felt proud & I don't know if Badal made any short speech even at the end. We left at about 8-30 PM. Programme was on though scheduled to end by 9 PM.

Today morning I think programme was repeated at Pargat Avenue ASR. We did not go. Press will carry a report tomorrow morning.

I don't know why I am writing to you. Maybe because despite our many differences in the course of our political lives, we have had much in common too.

I hope both you & Urmilaji are maintaining as good ~~see~~ health as you can possible have at the present stage of your lives. We are as usual.

Vimla Dang is a well-known public figure of Punjab. She is the patron of Punjab Istri Sabha an affiliate of The All India Women Federation. She was awarded Padam Shree in 1992. But it would be no exaggeration to say that the real award that she relishes most is the love and affection of the people of Punjab with whom she identified herself and whom she served with rare single-mindedness for the last six decades.

In early 'fifties of the last century soon after their marriage Satya Pal and Vimla came to Amritsar and settled at Chhekerta, an industrial suburb. Here they set an example of how workers are organised, how people are ~~kept~~ helped in their day-to-day life and how a municipal committee is run in the interest of ordinary citizens. Both have represented their assembly constituency. In the prevailing political culture where corruption is quite common the two leaders as MLAs stood out as embodiment of clean public life. For the last ten years they have upheld their pledge of not accepting any office. That, however, does not mean the end of their public work. Despite their weak health and advanced age both are actively engaged in attending to people's

grievances and demands.

A glimpse of their idealism can be had by reading 'Pages from a ~~Diary~~ Diary' ~~by~~ a small autobiography written by Vinula Dang. Here is a picture of a world where dreams of a revolution were nurtured <sup>and</sup> where hope and faith in country's bright future were strong. It is a life of young student leaders and workers who in the forties and early 'fifties built organisations and introduced their people ~~into~~ <sup>to</sup> the concerns of freedom movement and world politics. They developed a cultural wing of their organisation which served as an effective platform and medium of communication.

The two young activists who came from diverse backgrounds and ~~a~~ widely different upbringing and) came close to each other, became friends ~~and~~ decided to marry. Their faith in a bright future of humanity and their intense desire to uproot an unjust social system sustained them through many a trial. Vinula's story is in fact the story of this relationship ~~of~~ how softly and warmly it flourished. The autobiography reads almost like a novel.

In order to make it still more readable and interesting the author has changed the names of the two protagonists, and also of their relatives. But the names of some leading figures in public life with whom she had to

of those days)

interact, have not been changed.

This autobiography was originally only a diary. It was due to the insistent persuasion of ~~her~~ friends that she agreed to write it in this form. The result is that it is free of any infirmities of a diary and has all the qualities of a ~~fine~~ piece of fiction. This technique helps the author to treat her characters with due objectivity. Rashmi, ~~which~~ in fact is Vinla herself has been shown, ~~to be~~ ~~attracted~~ while at school, to be attracted by patriotic songs. The atmosphere of her home at Lahore was permeated with the spirit of enlightenment and progressivism. It was in this home that the earliest activities of the 'Friends of the Soviet Union' were planned. Vinla's brothers were the real movers. Suharini, a prominent Communist of those days was the inspirer. She was the youngest sister of Sarojini ~~Das~~ Naidu. In 1927 when Jawaharlal Nehru had visited the Soviet Union with his father Motilal Nehru and sister Krishna Suharini was in Moscow. After her marriage to Jambekar, she was known as Suhisin Jambekar.

who,

Intense political and cultural activities and ~~progress~~ discussions among the young people frequenting her home formed the background in which Vinla grew while still at school. A wall newspaper was another enterprise which published not only political news but also news and comments about social

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and personal matters. Members of this group were ~~just~~ inspired by an intense desire to achieve something in their life.

Rashmi's mother was a highly qualified school teacher. She composed songs as well. Members of the family used to sing together. Thus a squad of singers was formed. Rashmi accompanied the Punjab delegation to the first Congress of the Communist Party of India held at Bombay in 1943. She was greatly impressed by the legendary revolutionary of the Ghadar Party, Baba Sohan Singh Bhakna. ~~It~~ was at Bombay that Rashmi had her first meetings with Sukant i.e. Satya Pal. But these were brief and formal. She was enrolled in the Communist Party.

[Students] ~~from~~ Punjab made a memorable contribution during the Bengal famine of 1943. Funds, clothes, medicines ~~was~~ were collected from Lahore and other places and taken to famine-stricken areas of Bengal. It was during this work that Rashmi and Sukant gained first-hand experience of the miserable life in Bengal countryside.

Vinoda has described the student procession in January 1946 in Bombay. Her narration provides the reader with an insight into the common activity of the Communists and the Congressmen in the fight for country's freedom. She has also referred to communal riots. Here she was not an observer but fighter in the forefront. Some hoodlums tried to disrupt the procession and teased the participant girls of the All India Students Federation. However, Party cadres and the staff of

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Party newspapers gave such demerits a befitting rebuff. Among these Party fighters was the famous actor Balraj Sahni who was active on the cultural front.

In the last week of the year 1946 took place the naval revolt. At the same time the infantry men and the armed contingents of the Air Force turned their guns towards their British officers. The naval ratings at Karachi, Madras and Calcutta also joined the

put) ~~set up~~ a blockade and all supplies of coal, food or even water were stopped. Students and citizens of Bombay defied the military terror and helped the strikers in every possible way.

With such historic events as a background the love between Rashmi and Sankant flourished. Another girl also entered the life of Sankant. But in Vinla's account ~~of~~ there is no evidence of an intimate relation<sup>ship</sup> between these two. There were perhaps Vinla's own doubts and fears. Because of these and also because of excessive caution and reserve ~~that~~ a certain apparent coolness also developed between Rashmi and Sankant.

Vinla's autobiography also contains an account of his elder brother Shashi. At the young age of 25 he met his death when the freedom movement had acquired unusual intensity. He was rapidly establishing

himself as a ~~poet~~ people's poet. He had gone to donate blood for those who ~~were~~ had been injured ~~in~~ during the course of the demonstrations. But the needle used to take his blood had been infected. This death was a ~~so~~ terrible blow for Rashmi's family. Her father had died three years earlier.

It was in Prague, ~~the~~ Czechoslovakia, that Rashmi and Sukant owned up their relation of mutual love. Both of them had gone there to discharge their respective responsibilities in the international student movement.

at Prague Describing the First Youth Festival Vimla had drawn the following picture:

"It was evident that such a successful event could not be organized without the help of the government which was, of course committed to a policy of peace. Excellent facilities for the stay of thousands of foreigners, arrangements for their transportation and the handing over of the theatres, cinema halls, schools and open spaces to the organizers of the festival alone could make the event a grand success."

In this remarkable autobiography a thought-provoking comment of Professor Ravi Bakaya has been added at the end. Vimla's brother Professor Bakaya is a well-known scholar who retired



from The Jawaharlal Nehru University, Delhi. He is also the editor of the book. He has provided information on some of the leading P. Party cadres of those days. Some of the details concerning Party's policy and dealings of the comrades are interesting. Many of these relate to Vimla's account though she herself has not mentioned them.

This is a story of youthful idealism, of hope and faith when one is prepared to give everything in the service of a cause. The crucial question is how one lives up to this calling. ~~By their total dedication~~ Vimla and Daug ~~have proved that~~ stand out as an example of total dedication and devotion to the cause of the country and of the Party.



Heaps of refuse can be seen in various parts of Chheharta can be seen, including on G.T. Road as well as many other parts of Chheharta, till as late at 11 AM or even later.

Removal at many place of 'kora' is not done fully but only partly & what remains is levelled & flattened to remain there for the whole day.

Situation is particularly bad on Mondays because of accumulation of Sunday because Sunday is a holiday for all the Safai Karamcharis. I have been pleading that in view of the nature of their work, weekly holiday in case of sweepers should be staggered. There should be no common one weekly holiday. Sweeping & removal work should go on every day. Every sweeper should get one weekly holiday in lieu of Sunday. There should be adequate number of leave reservists.

Kindly, pay personal attention to this whole matter & give necessary instructions.
