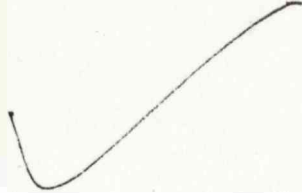

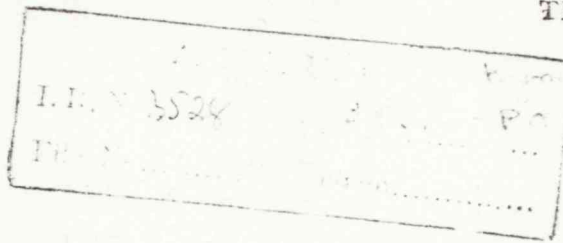

You will see from the above address, I have been staying here with my son, & will be here till 1st or 2nd Nov 1961.

Your above letter was redirected from my home address to me & I received same yesterday evening. I thank you for same & have noted its contents.

I am sorry, due to lack of any information from the affiliated Unions as regards their grievances in respect of the implementation of the Wage Board Award and also the outcome of the work done by Product Team at some centres as well as how far the amenities etc suggested in draft ~~the~~ report of the Tripartite (Technical) Committee have been put into effect. I am at a loss to suggest any concrete items which can be forced upon them. So far my knowledge goes, The employers have not in many cases put & in some cases absolutely implemented the Wage Board Award. We will have to enquire from the Unions about same.

I presume, during April 1961, at a meeting of the Cement Unions affiliated to AITUC, in New Delhi, discussions must have taken place in respect of the Wage Board Award's implementation. I had called for the gist of the happenings there, but I was not favoured with any information. After that meeting, The Fed called a meeting of the Council Council to discuss & prepare a statement of claims in respect of Bonus disputes before the National Tribunal, but it did not transpire

In the circumstances, I shall thank you to send me your views & items of Agenda you may be submitting.
